Every November the Region provides an opportunity to catch up on the last year's legal changes, look forward to those of the next and review areas of practice. Questions and discussion are an important part of the conference. This year we also have a visit and address by Ann Skippers, RTPI President.

This is an exceptional period for the planning system. The Coalition Government has brought together Conservative "Localism" and Liberal Democrat Community Politics. The Coalition Agreement is being implemented with vigour: the revocation of RSS, the resulting policy vacuum and the proposals for the IPC are headline items. The Conference will take stock of the current position and consider the Localism Bill. Recent case law will be examined together with changes to the UCO and the GPDO and the commencement of the CIL Regulations. There will be reviews of enforcement and of the protection of biodiversity.
